





#### FOUNDER PRINCIPAL

Blue Bells Model School started in the year 1980 with a dream to initiate an exemplary educational institution in Gurgaon The school started in a hired building **Inder** Bhawan, H. No. 984, Sector 4, on the main road, with a total strength of 9 students which increased to 85 students by March 1981 and then increased to 250 by March 1982 with Classes Nursery to V and then adding one class every year. Due to the constraint of space another building Taneja House was hired.

D.R. Memorial Bal Shiksha Vikas Society was formed on Dec 3 1981, and registered with the Registrar of Firms and Societies Haryana vide no. 522 under the Societies Act XXI of 1860 as its Apex body and the school was handed over to the Society. Mr. B.D. Gulati was elected as the Founder Chairperson of the Society. Mrs. Saroj Suman Gulati was appointed as the Principal of the school and as the Secretary/ Convenor of the Society to co-ordinate the working of the school and Society.

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
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# Strength Doubled: 570

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





### Milestones Conquered 1983 - 1984

The year **1983** was a momentous one in the history of Blue Bells when land was allotted in Sector – 4 and the foundation stone was laid for a Senior Secondary School.

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The application was filed with HUDA for the allotment of land for a Senior Secondary School. On Nov 21, 1983, the land was allotted to the society.



#### In the session **1983-84** the student's strength was **791** and classes up to VI.



The foundation stone of the building was laid on Feb 19, 1984, and the construction of the building started for the Senior Secondary School at Sector 4, opposite Ram Park.



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In 1984-85 the student's strength was 1098 with classes up to VII. In the session 1985-86 the student's strength rose to 1395 with classes up to VIII. The great day came on **July** 29,1985 when the school shifted to its present premises and started its growth towards a senior secondary school. With sincere dedication and efforts of the Management, the senior secondary school was initiated in its modest building with only the ground floor and one wing.



The school filed the application for affiliation with CBSE on Sept. 18, 1985.




# Spreading Our Wings

Started with limited resources in a rented accommodation, the school grew steadily with the concerted efforts of the Management. The strength of the staff increased with every passing year. Additional floors were added to cater to the needs of the growing strength of the school. Spacious and wellventilated rooms, a huge playground, and a well-furnished library was provided.



A separate Science Block, fitted with the most modern equipment's was constructed to promote scientific temper and every effort was made to provide maximum facilities to the students. The pedagogy of the school even in the early 80's focused on research and Inquiry based learning along with achieving academic excellence





On **12th May 1986** , Our student R. **Venkatesh** was awarded the first prize in a competition organized by S.C.E.R.T.

On 14th Nov 1986 the District Child Welfare Council organized an On-the-Spot Painting Competition. He was also declared the Best Artist in the competition.



- On 28th November 1986 a Hindi Debate was held at S.D.A. Bal Vidya Mandir. Mayank of class IX and Swati of Class VIII represented the school.
- ✓ Our school participated in the Math Olympiad (Class IX) for the first time. Out of 24 students 22 qualified and 14 were in merit list.

- In 26th Oct. 1986 Nehru Bal Samiti organized the On The Spot Painting Competition at Rotary Public School. In this Competition we were successful in getting 3 first prizes, 4 second prizes, and 4 third prizes. We sent 55 entries to All India Child Art Exhibition, Guntur. Our 20 paintings were selected. A.P. John Vishesh of class III got a silver medal. There were 2 fifth prizes and 3 Special prizes.




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The FIRST BATCH of the Students of class X. 18 students appeared in the Board Examinations in March 1988.

In the session 1987-88 our first batch of class X appeared for the Board Examination conducted by CBSE. The results were highly commendable and encouraging.





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The first decade of **BLUE BELLS MODEL SCHOOL** was a saga of its earnest efforts to usher in transformational changes in the field of education. The year **1980** marked a revolutionary change in how education was being imparted in the already existing schools of Gurgaon. With hardly any quality English medium schools, the town was still upcoming. Moving ahead from the traditional Black & Board teaching to Activity based learning and struggling to change the mind sets of this traditional town was an uphill task. Providing new wave training to the faculty, so that impetus is on concept building and not rote-learning was not easy going.
