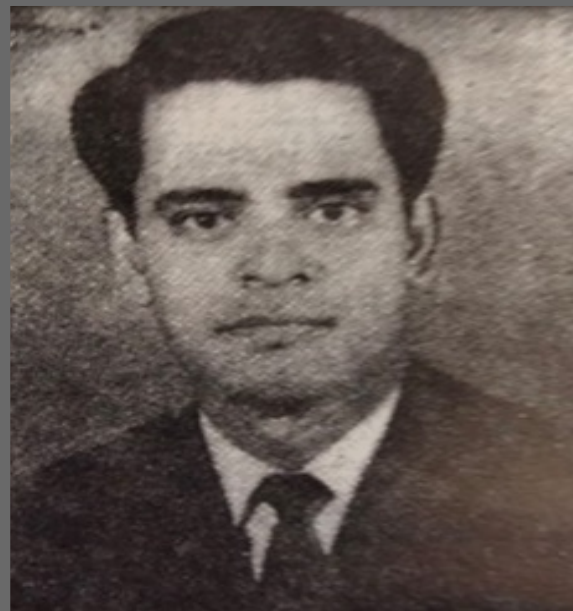

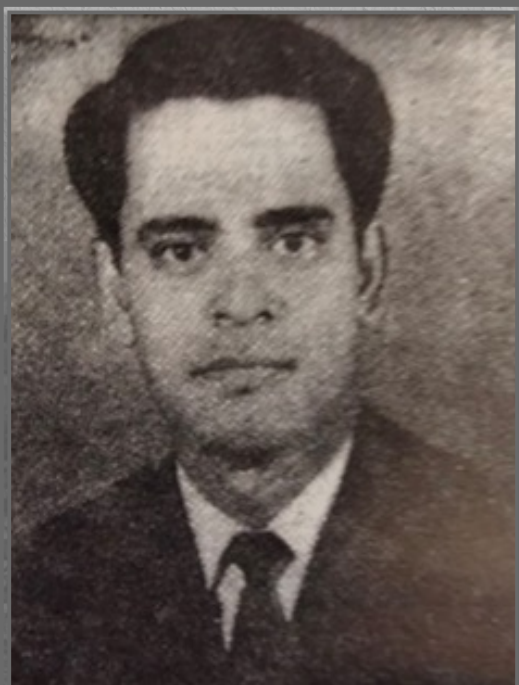

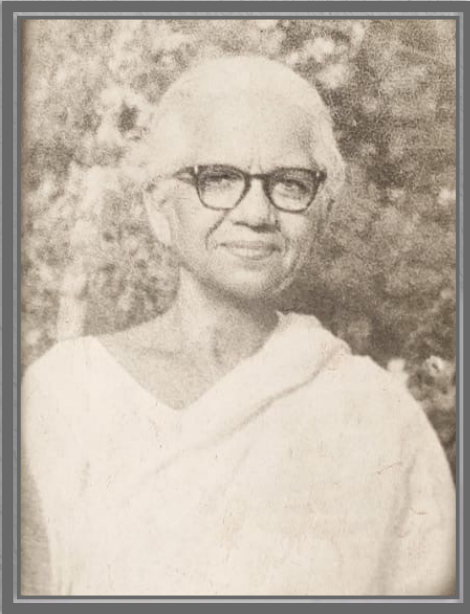

## FOUNDER PRINCIPAL

Blue Bells Model School started in the year 1980 with a dream to initiate an exemplary educational institution in Gurgaon

The school started in a hired building Inder Bhawan, H. No. 984, Sector 4, on the main road, with a total strength of 9 students which increased to 85 students by March 1981 and then increased to 250 by March 1982 with Classes Nursery to V and then adding one class every year. Due to the constraint of space another building Taneja House was hired.
