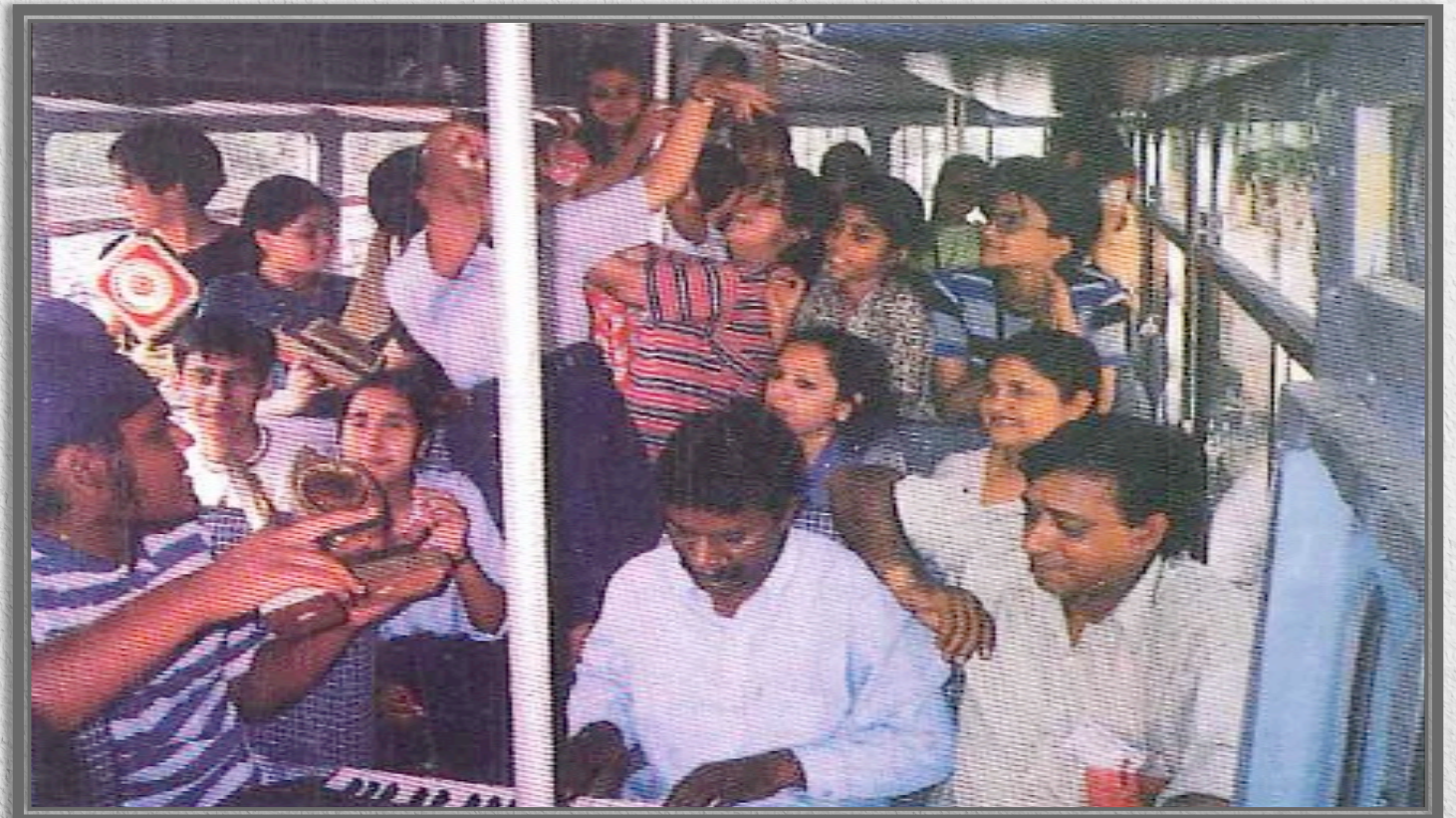

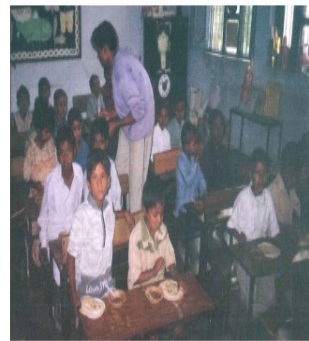
ACCOLADES
